

## GRAIN STORAGE CAPACITY Off-Farm and On-Farm

Capacity of **Off-Farm** commercial grain storage totaled 19.5 million bushels in SOUTH CAROLINA on December 1, 2007, 3 percent below December 1, 2006. With this capacity, South Carolina ranks 34<sup>th</sup> in the United States.

Off-farm grain storage facilities in South Carolina totaled 68 on December 1, 2007, down 3 from December 1, 2006.

**On-Farm** storage capacity is not published for South Carolina.
